Nomination:

This announcement is being sent to all teachers of French in public and private **high schools** in Rhode Island and requests that they select a student who best merits this award. Please fill out the attached **nomination form** with the information indicated.

Qualifications:

- 1. Junior or Senior student**
- 2. At least one (1) parent of the applicant must have some French-Canadian ancestry.**
- 3. Participation in *Le Grand Concours* (National French Contest) 2018**
- 4. According to the nominating teacher, the student has achieved excellence in the study of the French language and francophone cultures.**

Selection:

The Awards Committee will choose the **three (3) recipients** at random from the pool of all nominees received by the deadline date.

Award:

Each of the **three (3) recipients** will receive a cash award of **\$100**. The award will be presented at a ceremony in honor of RI students of French at **East Greenwich HS** on **Tuesday, 15 May 2018** at **6:15 PM**.

Note: *A student has the right to a single monetary prize at the Annual Ceremony for Students of French in RI.*

Deadline: The deadline for submitting nomination forms is **Wednesday, 9 May 2018**.
